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About Our Tastings

We taste wine in flights of usually no more than 10 wines. All tasting unless otherwise noted is done blind by the Editor.

The tasting coordinator (who does not taste) arranges and bags all wines, which are then scored and comments recorded before bags are removed. Our tastings are done under controlled, consistent conditions.

Here is **PinotReport's** 100-point scale:

96-100	SUPERIOR; it doesn't get better.
90-95	OUTSTANDING; approaching the best
80-89	ABOVE AVERAGE; a fine Pinot.
70-79	AVERAGE; OK if it's all you have.
60-69	BELOW AVERAGE; not recommended.
50-59	UNDRINKABLE.
